

“CAMPO DE’ FIORI ” APARTMENT

Sleeps 2+1

The apartment is composed of a living room with sofa bed, Mezzanine with a queen sized bed. Bathroom with shower. Wifi. Air Conditioning.

On the first floor, without a lift, of a historic building (one of the most ancient in the area), the “Campo De’ Fiori apartment”, transmits a sensation of pleasure and quietude due to its warm and pleasant atmosphere, and to the quiet zone where it is located.

The entrance leads straight into the romantic living room, which has a comfortable double sofa bed suitable for an extra person, LCD TV, Stereo System, Ipod dock station, books and DVDs, an elegant wooden dining table and a huge window that overlooks a typical and very old courtyard.

The very high, wooden ceiling is splendid and there is an original Renaissance decoration on the wall.

The night area is reachable through the stylish ironwork staircase and has a queen size bed and a chest of drawers for your clothes.

The apartment is equipped with linen and towels and they are changed weekly .

The kitchen is separate from the living area; it is modern and fully equipped with everything you need during your stay, making cooking a pleasure whenever you choose to cook some of the wonderful fresh vegetables bought at the local outdoor market.

The apartment is located in Via Monserrato which is one of the historical streets in Rome, famous for its antique furniture shops. In the past this street was the part of the "recta papalis" way for the papal processions. The present name of the street "Monserrato" comes from the Church dedicated to the Blessed Virgin of the famous Spanish sanctuary of Monserrat, 60 km far from Barcelona.

Campo de Fiori is within walking distance, the picturesque square, very popular especially at nights: is a popular gathering place for young adults, both locals and visitors, who travel here to enjoy the cafes and nightspots that surround the piazza.

The area is well served with public bus and taxi .

The price doesn't include Cleaning Fee, Towels and Linens, which is 65 euro.
Price will be increased by 15% between 22/12 and 06/01, and during the Easter week!
Please note that starting from September 1st 2014 a new tax, called “city tax” was introduced in Rome. Therefore you will be charged 3.50 euro per person per night. The tax shall be applied only in the first 10 days of the stay and children under 10 years old are exempt.

Check in between 2pm-6pm. Late check in fee after 6pm.
