

The **Fontana di Trevi Apartment** has an area of 120 sq. m., that can accommodate up to 6 people, and it is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, without lift, of a building in vicolo Scanderbeg .

Comprising a large lounge/dining area, two large double bedrooms, one with a romantic canopy bed, it has a double sofa bed in the lounge, a fully equipped live-in kitchen, including washing machine and dishwasher, a bathroom with tub and separate shower.

The floors are tiled with terracotta and part of the ceilings still conserves the exposed wooden beams, a characteristic of many ancient Roman homes.

The apartment has Central Heating, free Wi-Fi, no A/C, Fridge, Freezer, Toaster, Kettle, Coffee Machine, Microwave, Oven, Pots&Pans and Utensils, Hairdryer, Iron and Iron Board.

#### **The Location:**

The apartment is literally 2 minutes walking distance from the famous Trevi Fountain, which needs no introduction. This superb late baroque monument represents one of the most famous images of Rome.

Tradition has it that you will return to Rome if you throw a coin into the fountain's water basin. You should toss it with your right hand over your left shoulder (or left hand over your right shoulder) with your back to the fountain. You're not allowed to look behind you while you're tossing the coin but the fountain is so large it's basically impossible to miss.

The entire area is well served with shops of every variety, restaurants and bars.

It is close to taxi, buses and the metro (Barberini stop)...a favourite starting point from which to discover the many other marvellous sights in the "Eternal City".

From Leonardo da Vinci Fiumicino (FCO) airport Rome: by train to the Termini station (Leonardo Express train every 30 minutes). Underground line A for two stops, direction Battistini and get off at Barberini. Walk 450 m to the Avignonesi Street - Via dei Servi - Via del Lavatore - Vicolo Scanderbeg 91

From Ciampino Airport Rome(CIA): by bus to Termini Station, then follow the same path as in the case of FCO airport.

Price doesn't include cleaning fee, which is 65 euro.

Price will be increased by 15% between 22/12 and 06/01, and during the Easter week!

Please note that starting from September 1st 2014 a new tax, called "city tax" was introduced in Rome. Therefore you will be charged 3,50 euro per person per night. The tax shall be applied only in the first 10 days of the stay and children under 10 years old are exempt.

Check in between 2pm-6pm. Late check in fee after 6pm.
