

The **St. John Lateran Apartment** is located on the fifth floor with lift of a nice and quiet building, very close to the magnificent Saint John's Cathedral.

It is a very spacious apartment with Central Heating and free Wi-Fi; there you'll find, at the entrance, a living room with its sofa, table with chairs, TV and a fully equipped kitchen, with Fridge, Freezer, Toaster, Oven, Microwave, Pots & Pans and Utensils, Coffee Machine, and also Washing Machine and Dishwasher.

The rest is composed of two bedrooms along the corridor, one with a double bed, another with three single beds, that can be turned into a double bed if requested and two independent bathrooms with shower.

From the main bedroom you can access to a small balcony.

LOCATION:

The area is well known in Rome as one of the most important for shopping, especially for fashion clothes, shoes and accessories and there is also a large choice of restaurants and pizzeria for every pocket, gardens, cinema and tourist attractions, such as the very important reliquary of Santa Croce in Gerusalemme, in which some frames of the Holy Cross are kept, and Porta Maggiore, Rome's largest monumental gate from the time of the emperors. The renowned clothes market of Via Sannio, open every morning (excluding Sundays), the underground (Line A, San Giovanni station) and the large variety of buses, satisfy every kind of need and also ensure fast and efficient transport to the many other beauties of Rome.

From Leonardo da Vinci Fiumicino (FCO) airport Rome: by train to the Termini station (Leonardo Express train every 30 minutes). "A" metro line for three stops towards Anagnina, get off at San Giovanni. Walk 150 meters - Via Magna Graecia, right onto Via Corfinio until arrival at number 9. From Ciampino Airport Rome (CIA): by bus to Termini Station, then follow the same path as in the case of FCO airport.

Arrival by car: Proceed towards the city centre, following signs for San Giovanni. At Porta Maggiore take Via Sannio, then Via Corfinio left until arrival at number 9.

The Price doesn't include cleaning fee, which is 65 euro.

Price will be increased by 15% between 22/12 and 06/01, and during the Easter week!

Please note that starting from September 1st 2014 a new tax, called "city tax" was introduced in Rome. Therefore you will be charged 3,50 euro per person per night. The tax shall be applied only in the first 10 days of the stay and children under 10 years old are exempt.
